

Meter Express Policy

Atlanta Gas Light uses MeterExpress, a program for establishing gas service in residential new construction. The program allows for the gas meter to be installed and left active shortly after the gas service line is run. The builder's licensed HVAC/plumbing contractor can then tie in the home's fuel line (after inspection approval) and light the appliances. The program has been very successful in allowing the HVAC/plumbing contractor to establish gas service as needed by the builder.

Although the program has been very successful, we have received several questions and concerns regarding connection fees and monthly bills. Based on your valued feedback, we are implementing the following changes:

Gas Bills

Effective August 31, 2005 the builder will no longer incur a gas bill on new residential construction, unless one or more of the conditions listed below are met:

- Builder requests that the account be activated;
- The meter registered more than 10 therms of gas;
- The new homeowner does not contact AGL to activate the account in their name.

Connect Fee

Provided the account is not activated, AGL will waive the \$00.00 connection fee for all builders effective August 31, 2005.

To summarize, the builder will no longer incur a connect fee for new residential construction and, according to the builder's individual needs, will minimize or eliminate the monthly gas bill.
